He took our Area's conscience to hold onto the money. He put this motion on the floor and he feels as if it is going to fail. Another Area wants to put all towards H&I, another Area does not want to send any to World, and another Area wanted to split it 50/50. H&I would have a budget of \$2,500 to \$3,000. Discussion followed on this money. Rusty speaks in support of the motion. Again, don't think this motion is going to pass at Region (Cody made the motion). What direction do we want to give Cody? As our RCM, we trust Cody to make a decision.
3. Convention in Lakeside? As much as Rusty thinks it would be a great idea to have a Lakeside convention he recognizes that when the Area folded the convention folded. He suggests that the Region pick up another convention in the Spring to replace this convention. Discussion followed. Brett wondered about inviting Northern to Lakeside Area. Brittney said to see if there is something we can do to help Northern. Jerry said all this starts at the home group. He can't fill positions in his home group so how would we fill positions for a convention at the Area. Outreach Chair for the Region is also going to attend some Northern meetings to see if the Region can help.

## Activities Chair report October 2021

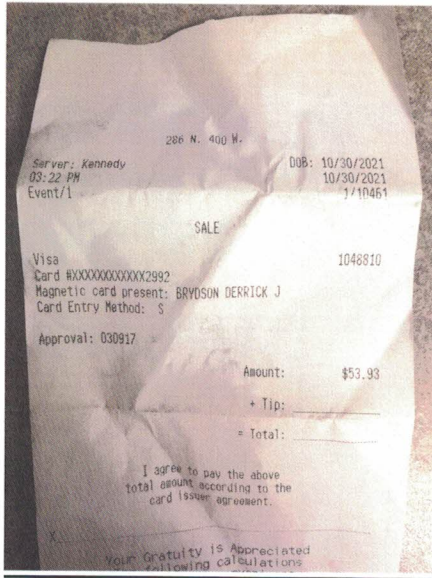
### **Pumpkin Carving / Bake Sale Activity:**

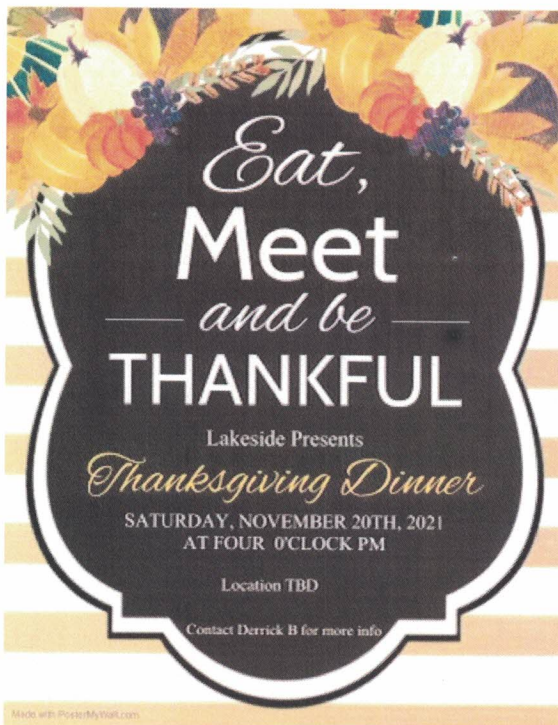

From October PR meeting: Last month talked about developing facility presentation and work on contacting these and other facilities (listed below) with this presentation. No progress made on this yet. Once a facility is interested, we will reach out to our fellowship for support for these facilities. Have not dove into this to deep yet. A decision was made that maybe would could do something, PR presentations. Discussion on what this would look like, to include Evanston. H&I vs. PR. Talking more about doing PR presentations. May be a hybrid with H&I if addicts are limited in leaving the facility to attend meetings on the outside. Set aside some time next month to put some resources together to determine what a presentation would look like? May look different for a PR presentation than it would for an H&I presentation. After we get the presentation together, contact each facility to see if we can present to them, give them individual attention.

Anthony said he went home and read the H&I manual and noticed a lot of the same verbiage. It talks about a lot of different types of institutions and what types of meetings should be held there. He noticed that when doing a presentation should fit information to audience. Also, need to consider manpower. Could put together some letterheads on what we have to offer but be conscience of where we send it. Start with a letter, then contact by phone to ask if the letter was received. Look at whether or not we have enough members to support said meeting if the facility should want one. Consider the length of stay at the facility, is it a year? Less? Plan to spend some time with the director of the facility to ask questions...do you want a staff in the meeting? Co-ed? All things to consider when doing PR work. A lot of valuable information to consider before taking a presentation into a facility. Anthony thinks we should come up with a list of H&I facilities and prioritize them.

1. Write a general letter on letterhead (template for all)—who we are and contact information and have a follow up process (when did we send, when do we contact). Also, ask for a reference, are there any other facilities that you can think of that may be able to use our services? Use the NA logo. Steve and DeLynda will work on a letter and bring to the next meeting.

2. Compile a list of facilities (jails, hospitals, rehabs, courts, judges, probation and parole, etc.). Keep track of each communication with each facility. Contact information for each facility is absolute necessity. Anthony will work on an initial list.
3. Go look and see at meetings we attend for people who look like they would be a good fit for these facilities. Make a list of members and phone numbers. When to follow up with these people (mail, phone call, etc.)

Goal is to have the letter and have the list. If the letter is effective and facilities want more, we will be prepared. How can we help you? Help addicts?

Use Google docs to track all follow up information. Anthony will create a general email for all to use.
