The Third Concept of Narcotics Anonymous

“The NA groups delegated to the service structure the authority necessary to fulfill the responsibilities assigned to it”

What Does This Mean?

In Narcotics Anonymous, groups work together to carry the message of recovery. Since groups cannot do every service task themselves, they give trusted servants and service committees the authority to carry out responsibilities on behalf of the fellowship.

This concept teaches us:

- Responsibility and authority go together
- Trusted servants need clear direction and support
- Delegation helps service work run smoothly
- Accountability is important at every level of service

Why Is This Important?

Without delegated authority:

- Service work would stall
- Every small decision would require full group approval
- Trusted servants could not effectively complete their tasks

By delegating authority:

- NA services can function efficiently
- Members can serve with confidence
- The fellowship can better carry the message to addicts seeking recovery

Examples of the Third Concept in

Action

- A group elects a GSR to represent them at area meetings
- An area committee assigns responsibilities to subcommittees
- Trusted servants are empowered to make routine decisions within their roles
- Service bodies carry out tasks entrusted to them by the groups

Questions for Discussion

1. Why is delegation important in NA service?
2. How can groups support trusted servants?
3. What happens when responsibility is given without authority?
4. How does accountability strengthen our service structure?

Remember

Delegating authority does not mean giving up responsibility. Groups remain ultimately responsible for NA services while trusting servants to carry out assigned duties faithfully and effectively. “Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our trusted servants.”
